INFORMATION FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS

Vaccine Schedule:

- **HPV-9** vaccine is a two-dose series (0, 6 months) when initiated before the age of 15. If the series is initiated at age 15 or older, HPV is a three-dose series (0, 2, and 6 months)
- **Hepatitis B** vaccine is a two-dose series (0, 6 months) when completed between the ages of 11-15 years. For children who have not received a 2nd dose prior to their 16th birthday, a 3-dose series is required.
- **Men-C-ACYW-135** is a single-dose vaccine. This is different from the meningococcal vaccine that is routinely given at one year of age.

- a. As of September 2022, all students in grades 7 to end of grade 12 are eligible for the publicly funded Hep B vaccine.
 b. Individuals aged 16 years and older require a 3-dose Hep B immunization schedule as per the [Canadian Immunization Guide](#).
 c. Females only as per publicly funded program criteria. Males in grade 7 became eligible in 2016. These males were born in 2004.
 d. Individuals aged 15 years and older require a 3-dose HPV-9 immunization schedule as per the [Canadian Immunization Guide](#).
