

ADVISORY: Infant RSV Expected to Peak in January

December 12, 2024

Key Information

- Infant RSV infections are expected to peak during the week of January 6th, 2025
- Health care providers are encouraged to promote RSV vaccination, particularly over the coming weeks
- RSV vaccines can be ordered from Peterborough Public Health

According to the Ministry of Health, current forecasting shows that infant RSV infections in Ontario are expected to peak the week of January 6th, 2025. RSV vaccination remains a critical component of infection prevention, particularly in the weeks leading up to the expected peak. All infants born in 2024 are eligible for RSV vaccination (either in-hospital or from their primary care provider), as well as vulnerable children in their second RSV season.
