1. Summary of duties:

Works with the Smoke-Free Ontario Act Tobacco Enforcement Officers during vendor compliance and enforcement checks.

2. Minimum qualifications and position requirements:

Demonstrated effective ability to perform the following:

- Accompany enforcement officer to premises that sell tobacco and e-cigarettes.
- Purchase tobacco and/or e-cigarettes in accordance with protocol, and if successful, turn over the tobacco and/or e-cigarettes, and the receipt, if provided, to the enforcement officer.
- Provide a summary of each retail visit to the enforcement officer.
- Create accurate and descriptive notes and communicate clearly these observations to the enforcement officer.
- Has the flexibility and ability to attend court and testify under oath the actions taken and observations made, if and when the need arises.
- Sixteen years of age.
- Appropriate valid identification for use during court.
- Observe and recall visual/factual information accurately.
- Listen and follow directions.
- Practice conflict resolution skills.
- Demonstrate continuous reliability.
- Ability to work well and cohesively with others.
- Good written and verbal communication skills.
- Must be tobacco-free for at least six months.
- Must have the flexibility and willingness to work evenings and weekends.
- Maintain up-to-date immunization according to the Ontario Publicly-Funded Immunization Schedule and/or the most recent edition of the Canadian Immunization Guide and the National Advisory Committee on Immunization as per the Peterborough Public Health policy, including being fully vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine series.
