East side of parking lot.

### Modular Bridge Housing (210 Wolfe St.)

East side of building - outside of washrooms.

### Fire Station #1 (210 Sherbrooke St.)

Outside wall.

### Millennium Park Trail (131 King St.)

Near café/train tracks - in public washrooms.

### East City Parkette (between Maria St. & train bridge)

East side of Otonabee River.

### Roger's Cove (131 Maria St.)

Outside public washrooms.

### Beavermead Park (2011 Ashburnham Dr.)

Outside public washrooms.

### Del Crary Park (2 George St. N.)

Pathway near parking lot.

### Brock & Bethune St.

South-East corner near Fleming Park.

### YES Shelter for Youth & Families (196 Brock St.)

South side of building.

### King Edward Park (455 George St. S.)

Inside public washrooms.

### Simcoe & Bethune Park

Near garbage bins.
